A Summer Reminder, as a result of so many calls regarding DOGS.

Eagle County and the subdivision you have chosen to live in has rules concerning DOGS, dogs are welcome, in addition...

- 1.Keep all dogs on a leash at all times when off your property and in our subdivision. This includes jogging, pushing a stroller, riding a bike, exercising your animals, etc.
- 2. Do not allow your dog to roam off your property. Visiting a neighbor, running out to greet walkers, eliminating on private property, going after garbage at the curb, and chasing innocent wildlife, all of these behaviors are annoying and illegal in our community.
- 3. Do not allow your dog to bark unrestricted. Inappropriate hours at night or unrelenting barking during the day are neither neighbor friendly or legal.
- 4. People walking alone or with children should not have to fear your unleashed, friendly, happy dog.
- 5. Please clean up after your dog especially along the road in front of others' property.

The Sheriff should be alerted when our subdivision is requiring their help. Whether you observe someone watching your DOG chase wildlife or stopping on private property, or not, someone will be calling the sheriff, and you will be fined. If you wish to report an infraction, you can obtain a Citizen Incident Report Form from Eagle County Animal Control by calling 970-328-3647 (fax-970-328-2442).
